

Volunteering Opportunities in our Tuckshop

We recognise our volunteers want to contribute to our tuckshop in different ways, so we offer a range of opportunities to suit everyone.

Regular Volunteers

Our volunteers are placed on a roster once a month (or more often for anyone wanting to volunteer on a more regular basis) and we offer a number of time slots, from a full day shift to a one-hour shift.

Theme Day Volunteers

Our theme days are held during each term and are lots of fun for students and volunteers. Volunteers are needed to assist with the preparation of the theme day menu.

Home Bake Volunteers

We provide our home bakers with a standard recipe, such as muffins, to bake at home and deliver to the tuckshop.

Donated Goods Scheme Volunteers

Parents who wish to make a contribution to the tuckshop, but cannot do so physically are encouraged to make donations of regularly used pantry and packaging items to the tuckshop. A list of our regularly used items can be obtained from the tuckshop.

Volunteer Training

We provide training to all our volunteers in food safety and good hygiene practices, use of tuckshop equipment and other training as required by the school.

Home bake volunteers will receive training in food safety and good hygiene practices.
